

How do I find appropriate support for my child with autism so that I can get a break?

Parenting a child with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) can be a lot of work, and at times, very stressful. Taking care of yourself is an important way of ensuring that you have the energy and focus to be a successful caregiver to your child and family. Caring for yourself may include alone ("me") time, physical activity, spending time with your significant other, and/or with friends and family. Respite is specialized childcare that allows you to get a much-needed break so that you can care for yourself. Respite care can be funded through the Family Support for Children with Disabilities (FSCD) or the Persons with Developmental Disabilities (PDD) programs. See Tip Sheet on "Funding".

- Think in practical and realistic terms about what type of respite would work best for your family.
- Plan regular breaks and put them into your schedule.
- Think about the type of caregiver that could best provide support.
- Respite can be provided inside or outside of the family's home.
- To find a respite worker, check the resources below and/or the job boards or websites of universities and colleges. You can post a job profile on these websites indicating the hours and days that you require support.
