QUICK SCREEN CHECKLIST

Is HomeSpace Downtown right for me?

- I am interested in living independently in a 74 unit affordable housing apartment building in downtown Calgary that includes autistic adults and other tenants.
- I have a means of transportation (e.g., can use the bus system or C-train independently). Parking spaces will be limited.
- I am independent with essential activities of daily living (e.g. grocery shopping, cooking meals, bathing, housekeeping, laundry and am able to self-evacuate the building without assistance in an emergency).
- I would benefit from a monthly call with Autism Calgary Association and a monthly social event with others in the building planned by Asperger's Friendship Society. The monthly cost for support is \$60 and is a requirement to live in these specific units.
- I have a reasonable plan to afford to pay \$615 (studio) to \$740 (one bedroom) a month for rent, plus utilities (\$60 a month) and support costs (\$60 a month).
- I can also afford to pay for any additional personal expenses (e.g. food, clothing, cell phone, entertainment, transportation).
