QUICK SCREEN CHECKLIST

Is Horizon View right for me?

- I am interested in living independently in an affordable housing apartment building in the Glamorgan community of Calgary that includes autistic adults and other tenants.
- I have a means of transportation (e.g. can drive, use the bus system independently).
- I am independent with essential activities of daily living (e.g. grocery shopping, cooking meals, bathing, housekeeping, laundry and am able to self-evacuate the building without assistance in an emergency).
- I would benefit from one weekly phone call check-in and one monthly social event planned by Monarch House. The monthly cost for support is \$60 and is a requirement to live in these specific units.
- I have a reasonable plan to afford to pay \$800 - \$900 a month for rent, plus utilities and to pay the support cost of \$60 per month.
- I can also afford to pay for any additional personal expenses (e.g. food, clothing, cell phone, entertainment, transportation).

**A one-time fee of \$120 is paid to Monarch House for initial assessment to determine support needs. Additional supports can be purchased from Monarch House as required.
