



AUTISTIC EXPERIENCES IN JOB INTERVIEWS

INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE

What does this study involve?

Researchers in the Department of Psychology at the University of Calgary are currently seeking volunteers to participate in a research project aimed at exploring the experiences of late-diagnosed autistic people in job interviews.

Participation in this study will involve a short survey, questionnaire, and an hour-long interview. Participants will be compensated with a \$25.00 gift card.

Who is eligible to participate?

Autistic adults with a formal- or self-diagnosis, whose diagnosis/discovery occurred in adulthood (18 years of age or older).

Eligible participants will have participated in at least one job interview in the last year, and the interview must have occurred since their autism diagnosis/discovery.
